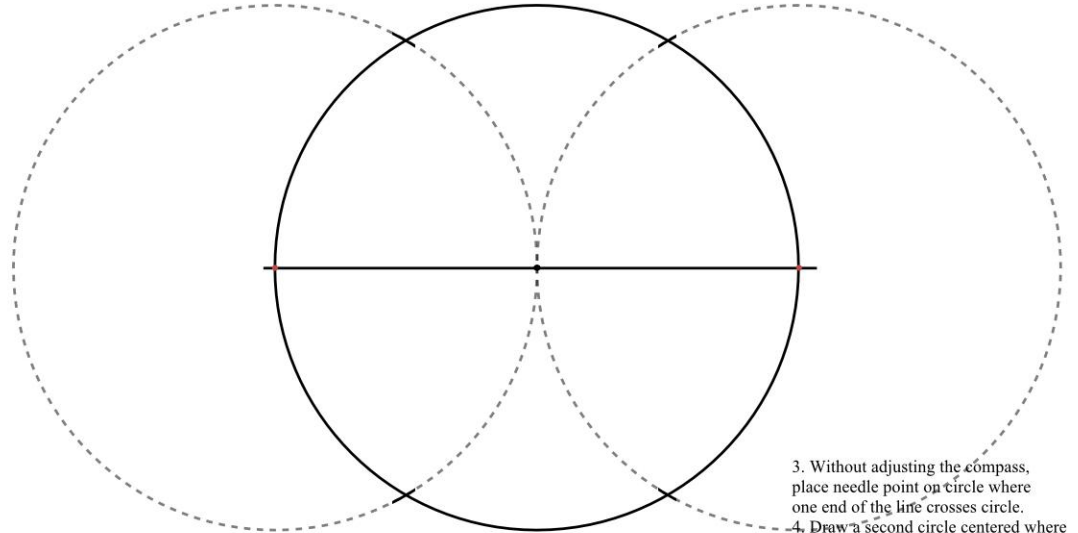
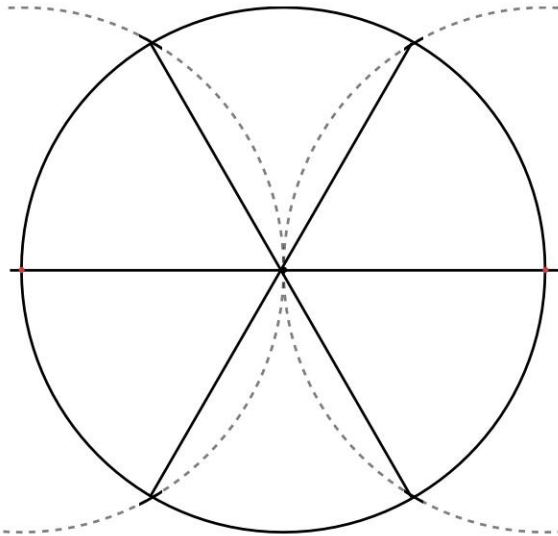


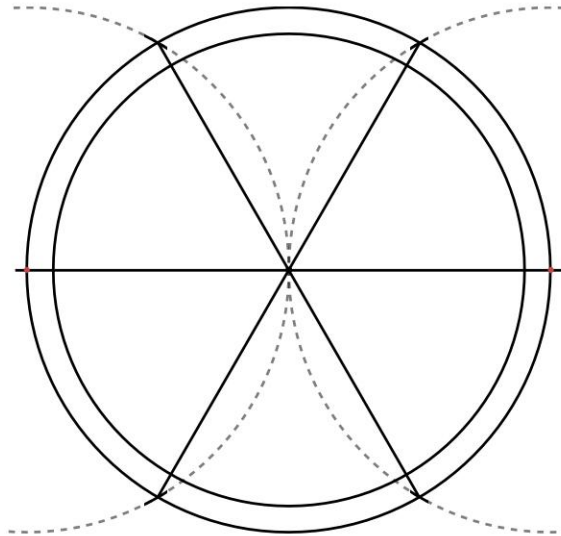
1. With a compass set to a space of 5" between the needle point and pencil point, draw a 10" diameter circle.
2. Using a ruler, draw a line across circle that goes through the center point where the compass needle made a hole in paper.



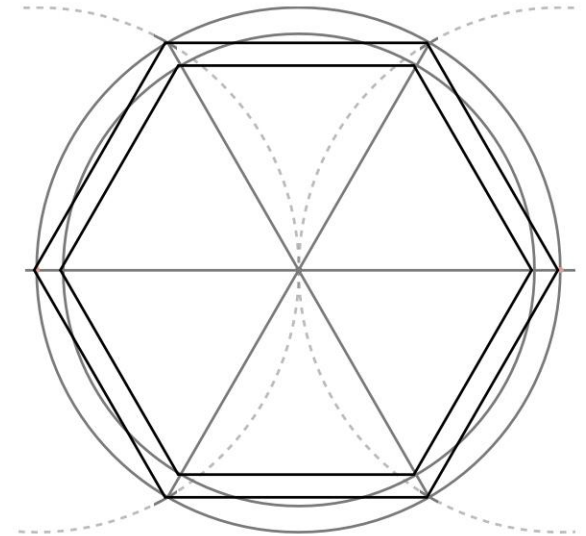
3. Without adjusting the compass, place needle point on circle where one end of the line crosses circle.
4. Draw a second circle centered where other end of line crosses circle. The circle is now divided into six equal segments.



5. With a ruler, draw lines from one mark on circle through center to opposite mark. Repeat for remaining two marks.



6. With the compass set to a 4 1/2" space, mark a second circle with same center as the first circle.



7. With a ruler, draw straight lines between each adjacent dividing mark on both circles. Cut out pattern on outer hexagon line.
